If a food pantry or meal program that you regularly visit is closed, if you have recently lost your job, or if you are homebound and do not have support to bring you food, you may be eligible for a free weekly home delivery of produce and shelf stable grocery items. To participate, call 617-349-9155. You will be prompted to leave a voicemail with your name, number, and address. A staff member will call you back within 24 hours to confirm that you meet the criteria for food item delivery. If you meet the criteria, you will be added to the weekly distribution list. 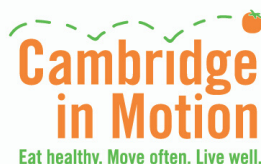
